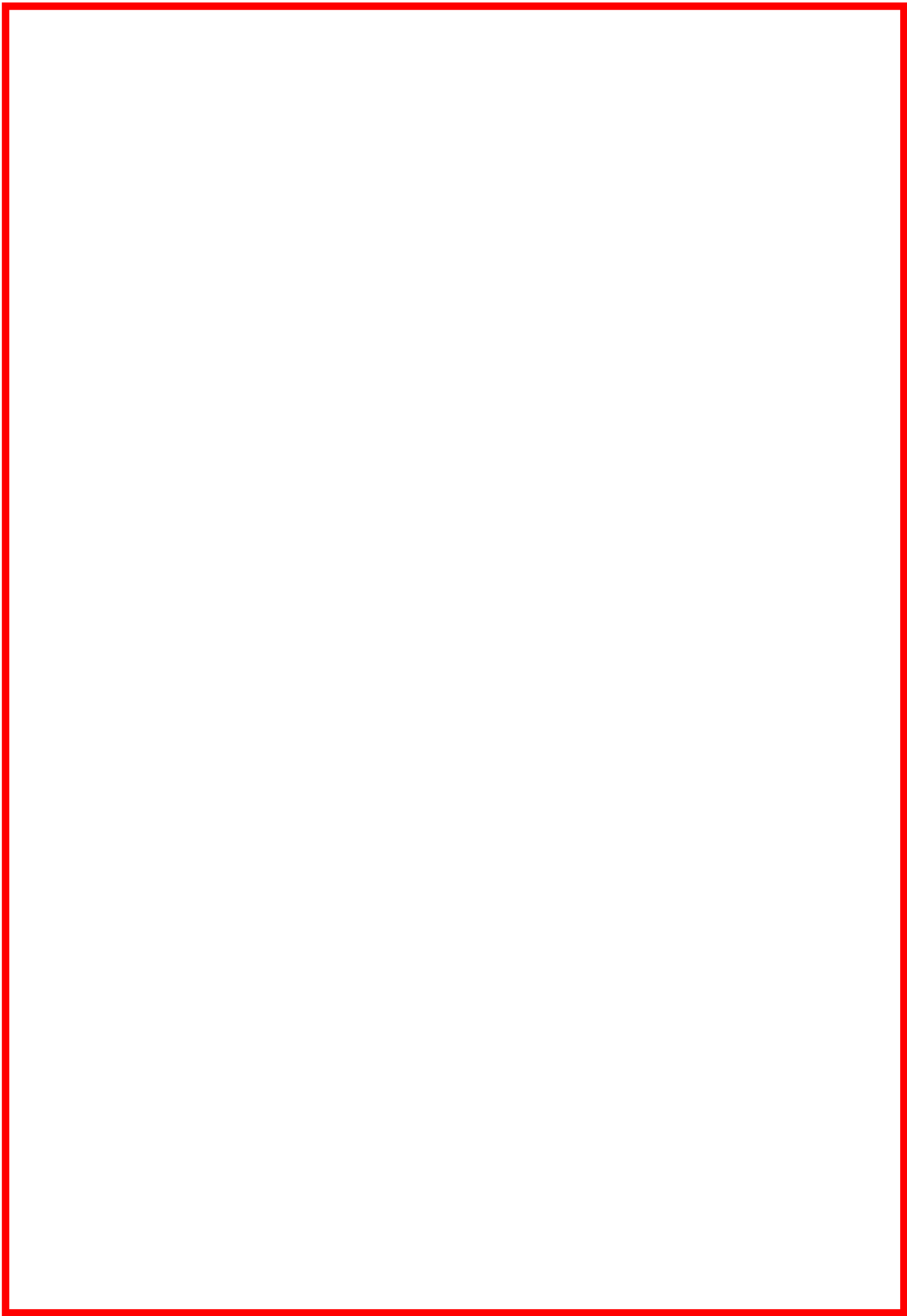

1. What did Jack sell?
Jack sold the cow.
2. What did Jack get in return for the cow?
Jack got some magic beans in return for the cow.
3. What grew in the garden?
A giant beanstalk had grown in the garden.
4. What did Jack see once he climbed to the top of the beanstalk?
When Jack finally reached the top, he saw an enormous castle.
5. What did the giant shout when he came into the room?
He shouted, "Fee, Fi, Fo, Fum, I smell the blood of an Englishman!"
6. What did Jack do when he heard the giant?
Jack heard a loud noise and hid.
7. How did the giant fall asleep?
The giant fell asleep as the harp sang.
9. How did they get rid of the giant?



Answers

1. What was the most expensive item that Jack and his mother owned?
Their most valuable possession was a cow.
2. Who gave Jack something in exchange for his cow? What was it?
A man gave him some magic beans in exchange for the cow.
3. How do you think Jack's mother felt when she found out what Jack had done with their cow?
His mother was angry because Jack only got magic beans in exchange for their cow when they needed money.
4. Where did the beanstalk grow?
A giant beanstalk had grown in the garden outside Jack's window.
5. How can you tell the beanstalk was high?
It was so tall, it went right up to the sky and through the clouds!
6. What was the giant's catchphrase?
"Fee, Fi, Fo, Fum, I smell the blood of an Englishman!"

7. How did the giant find out about Jack?

As he ran, the harp cried, "Help master!" and the giant woke up.

8. Describe how you think the giant's egg looked using three adjectives.

**(Answers will vary - accept any 3 reasonable adjectives to describe the golden egg.)
E.g. I think the egg looked golden, shiny and smooth.**

9. Who saved the day and how?

Jack's mother because she came out with an axe, used it to chop the bottom of the beanstalk and the giant fell and crashed to the ground.

10. Do you think it was a happy ending for everyone?

**(Answers will vary for the giant – it could be sad or a mystery as he was never seen again.)
It was happy for Jack and his mother because they lived happily ever after with the golden eggs and the magic harp. It was not happy for the giant because he fell, crashed to the ground and was never seen again.**
