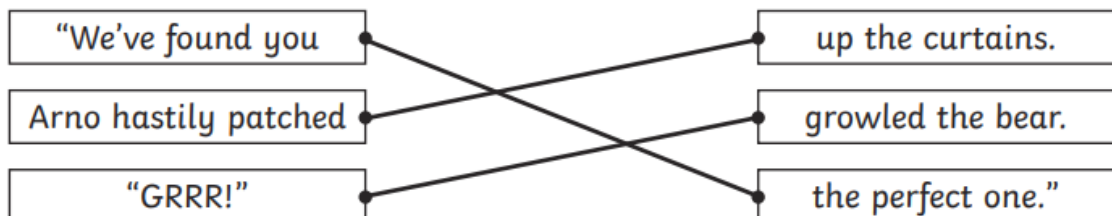

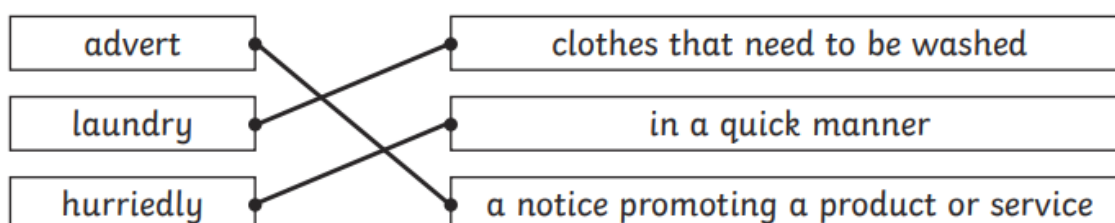
2. What is the first thing the bear does for the children?
