

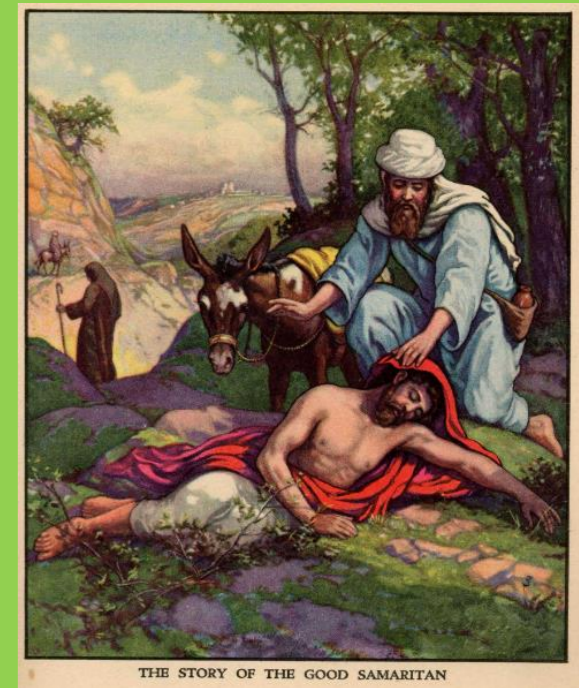

2. What is the message of this Parable? How does it inspire us to live our lives?

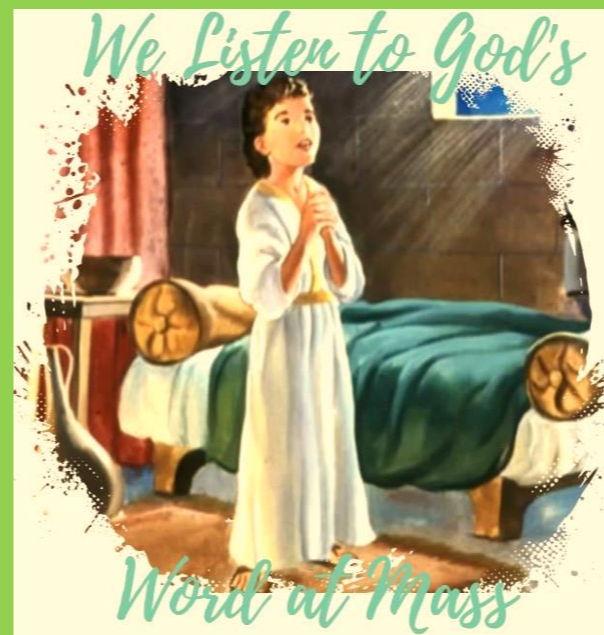

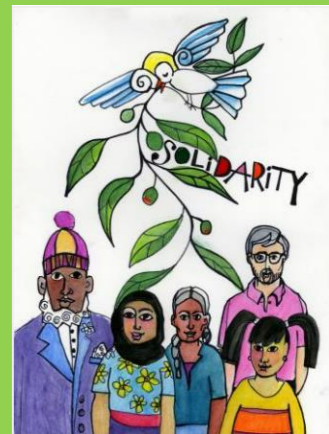

 What story from the Bible teaches you to care for others? What could you do to show you care?



Listening	Take notice of and act on what someone says Make an effort to hear something
Hearing	The ability to listen to sounds. Understand what is being communicated
Liturgy of the Word	The time when we listen to God, God speaks to us through the scripture readings
Old Testament	Section of the Bible with stories before Jesus was born, based on how the Jewish people lived. It is the Word of God. Where the First Reading comes from
Responsorial Psalm	Comes from the Book of Psalms in the Old Testament Written as a special form of song. In Mass, we listen to the reader and reply with a response
New Testament	Comes in two parts - the Gospel and the Letters from the Apostles. After Jesus was born Where the Second Reading comes from
Gospel	From the New Testament, telling us the story of Jesus and his teachings. Written by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John
