Communion Reflection

It was at the very moment Peter recognised his sinfulness that Christ challenged him to become a fisher of men. Peter knew that the only thing he could rely on was the word and the power of Christ.

We must not be put off by our weaknesses, or make an excuse out of them for doing nothing. Rather we must learn to turn them to our advantage. Listen to how Paul did this.

“Though I could boast I won’t. It’s true that I’ve had revelations, but to stop me from getting too proud I was given a thorn in the flesh. Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away, but he said: ‘My Grace is enough for you; my power is at its best in weakness.’

So I am not only content with my weaknesses, but I have actually learned to boast of them, for it is when I am weak that I am strong, because then the power of Christ is available to me.”
