Admission to St. Anne's Catholic Primary School

Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council co-ordinate the admissions process for St. Anne's School which includes any applications and school waiting lists for children in Reception to Year 6 - they can be contacted on 0121 704 6693 or via the Solihull MBC Website at www.solihull.gov.uk/admissions.

Families from local authorities beyond Solihull, including Birmingham City Council are welcome to apply for a school place at St. Anne's but will need to apply through their own local authority, further information can be located on their website link <https://www.birmingham.gov.uk/schooladmissions>. Reception to Year 6

Applications for **Reception** and **Secondary** school places for September 2026 must be made via the Council Website: <http://www.solihull.gov.uk/admissions>. If you live outside Solihull you must apply to your local council even if you want to include Solihull schools on your application.

Information for our Nursery Parents – applying for a Reception place for September 2026

Children with a date of birth between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 start full-time school in September 2026. This first year is called 'Reception'.

Please ensure you apply on-line via your local council before the closing date which is 15th January 2026.

Applying for a Nursery school place for September 2025

If your child was born between 1st September 2022 and 31st August 2023 you can apply for 30 hours free Nursery education in a Solihull school starting in September 2026. These applications are now made directly to schools and not via Admissions. St. Anne's application forms are available from the school office. To request one, please send your child's name, date of birth and your name and contact number to: nurseryadmissions@st-annes.solihull.sch.uk. Please type 'Nursery 2026' in the subject line so that we can easily identify your email. We will email an application form to you in due course.

Kindly note the closing date for receipt of Nursery 2025 applications is Friday 12th December 2025

All applications and Catholic Baptism certificates must be received in the school office by this date. You will be advised of the outcome of your application by email on Monday 15th December 2025.

Secondary applications have now closed. If you have not yet applied for your child's place for Secondary School in September 2026, please contact your local council directly. Thank you.

At St. Anne's Nursery children attend 5 morning sessions, 8.30am-11.30am Monday-Friday. (Total 15 hours)

For parents who require additional childcare hours we have an extended facility on site "Angels". This is independently run from school. It is Ofsted registered. The 'Angels' wrap around childcare facility which operates on the school site offers the provision of extra child care hours whether it is free due to circumstances or an additional cost to the family. This is a very popular and successful childcare facility which is managed by qualified staff with DBS clearance. By combining Nursery and Angels some of our children stay throughout the school day.

We also offer additional childcare for families from 8am and until 6pm Monday to Thursday and until 4.30pm on Fridays via Saints.

We will discuss these options further at the meeting so that each individual family receives their own childcare plan.

Some families are eligible for 30 free nursery hours linked to their financial situation and/or working arrangements. It is the responsibility of each individual to check if you are eligible to receive this funding, see links below.

If you require additional childcare over and above the 15 hours school nursery morning sessions please take some time to read the guidance on the links below. It is crucial that you note the important dates as to when you need to apply for the 30 hour funding codes.

It is the responsibility of the parent to organise funding and payment of childcare fees and to secure the 30 hour codes at the appropriate time and in advance of your child's start date.

School or Angels cannot accept responsibility for non-payment of childcare fees where the 30 hour code has not been provided by the parent.

All application forms along with Birth Certificates and Catholic Baptism certificates must be received in the school office by this date. You will be advised of the outcome of your application by email from Solihull Council on 16th April 2026.

Please note that when you apply for a **Nursery** or **Reception** place we follow the Admissions policy and we can only consider your child as Catholic if you have provided a baptismal certificate **before** the closing date for applications. We cannot accept that you intend to get your child baptised, even if the child's siblings are already baptised. Therefore, it is really important that if you are looking to organise a baptism this takes place before the closing dates for admissions.

If you wish your child to be baptised one parent must be a Catholic. If you wish to contact our Parish Priest, his telephone number is 0121 770 3283.
