Admission to St. Anne's Catholic Primary School

Applying for a Nursery school place for September 2026

Please apply for a Nursery pack via email by contacting the school office

If your child was born between 1st September 2022 and 31st August 2023 you can apply for 30 hours free Nursery education in a Solihull school starting in September 2026.

These applications are made directly to schools and not via Admissions. If you would like to request an application form for St. Anne's nursery, please send your child's name, date of birth and your name and contact number to: nurseryadmissions@st-annes.solihull.sch.uk. Please type 'Nursery 2026' in the subject line so that we can easily identify your email. We will email an application form to you.

Kindly note the closing date for receipt of Nursery 2024 applications is Friday 12th December 2025.

At St. Anne's Nursery children attend 5 morning sessions, 8.30am-11.30am Monday-Friday. (Total 15 hours)

For parents who require additional childcare hours we have an extended facility on site "Angels". This is independently run from school. It is Ofsted registered. The 'Angels' wrap around childcare facility which operates on the school site offers the provision of extra child care hours whether it is free due to circumstances or an additional cost to the family. This is a very popular and successful childcare facility which is managed by qualified staff with DBS clearance. By combining Nursery and Angels some of our children stay throughout the school day.

Parents have the option to pay for a dinner provided by the school kitchen at lunchtime or the children can bring their own lunch/snacks into school.

If your child needs to wear a nappy when they begin their journey in St. Anne's Nursery or the 'Angels' wrap around please be aware that it is the responsibility of the parent to provide school with a regular supply of nappies as needed.

We also offer additional childcare for families from 8am and until 6pm Monday to Thursday and until 4.30pm on Fridays via Saints.

We will discuss these options further at the meeting so that each individual family receives their own childcare plan.

Some families are eligible for 30 free nursery hours linked to their financial situation and/or working arrangements. It is the responsibility of each individual to check if you are eligible to receive this funding, see links below.

If you require additional childcare over and above the 15 hours school nursery morning sessions please take some time to read the guidance on the links below. It is crucial that you note the important dates as to when you need to apply for the 30 hour funding codes.

It is the responsibility of the parent to organise funding and payment of childcare fees and to secure the 30 hour codes at the appropriate time and in advance of your child's start date.

School or Angels cannot accept responsibility for non-payment of childcare fees where the 30 hour code has not been provided by the parent.

Key website links for further information about funding can be found below. We are sign-posting you to these websites for information, school staff are not in a position to advise on childcare fees/income from the government or benefits.

All application forms along with Birth Certificates and Catholic Baptism certificates must be received in the school office by this date. You will be advised of the outcome of your application by email on Monday 15th December 2025.

Please note that when you apply for a **Nursery** or **Reception** place we follow the Admissions policy and we can only consider your child as Catholic if you have provided a baptismal certificate before the closing date for applications. We cannot accept that you intend to get your child baptised, even if the child's siblings are already baptised. Therefore, it is really important that if you are looking to organise a baptism this takes place before the closing dates for admissions.

If you wish your child to be baptised one parent must be a Catholic. If you wish to contact our Parish Priest, his telephone number is 0121 770 3283.
