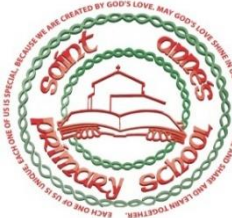


## Year 1- Home Learning

Our weekly celebration this week is: 'Have eaten a healthy, balanced diet' (healthy choices).

After this week we should be able to say:

- I know how to make healthy lifestyle choices ☺
- I feel good about myself when I make healthy choices ☺

Your task this week is to think of as many ways as you can about how you can make healthy choices whilst you are at home staying safe. You could:

- draw pictures and label all the healthy choices you have drawn
- take a photograph every time you do something healthy
- make a healthy snack, sandwich or meal (with the help of an adult)

As an extra task you could also write a sentence to describe how you feel when you make a healthy choice and why.

In art, we are looking at developing our skills in: design, drawing, craft, painting and art appreciation.

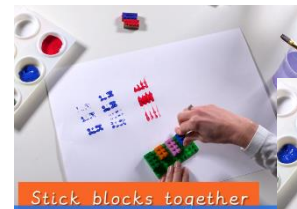
Our first lesson is 'Design: Lego Printing'

During this week, we would like you to use Lego (or anything similar- a potato print is good too/ a brick/stone from the garden/) to create your own prints; painting and stamping your Lego blocks to create patterns,



using a variety of colours and

1. Paint the bumpy side of your Lego block
2. Print the block onto your paper. Have a go at using different blocks with different colours



3. Experiment with sticking some of your Lego blocks together
4. You could try making a pattern or a picture



5. Try using your Lego blocks to create a letter. You will need to make the letter backwards so that it prints the right way around! Have a go at writing your initials.
