Ron is late!

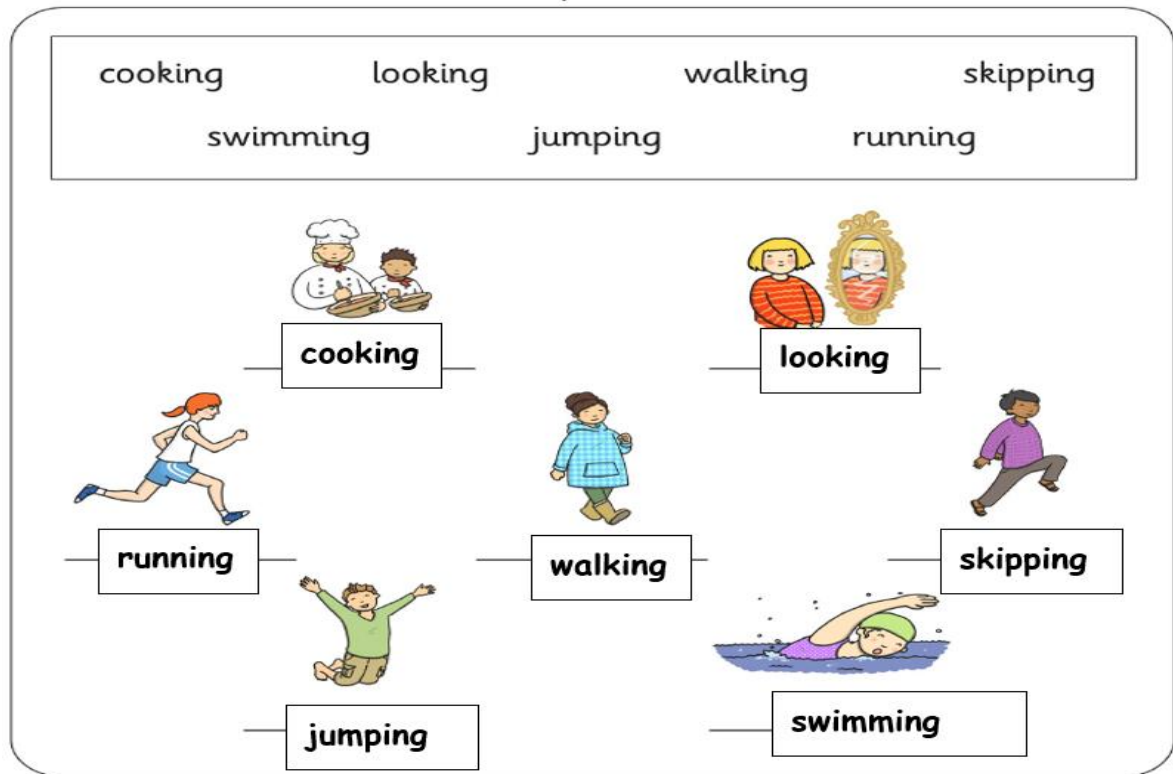

2b. cried, worried; stopped, shouting

3a. Sadie is incorrect because 'write' becomes 'wrote' in the past tense. She has added the '-ed' suffix incorrectly.

3b. Jasper is incorrect because 'funny' becomes 'funnier'. He has added the '-er' suffix incorrectly.

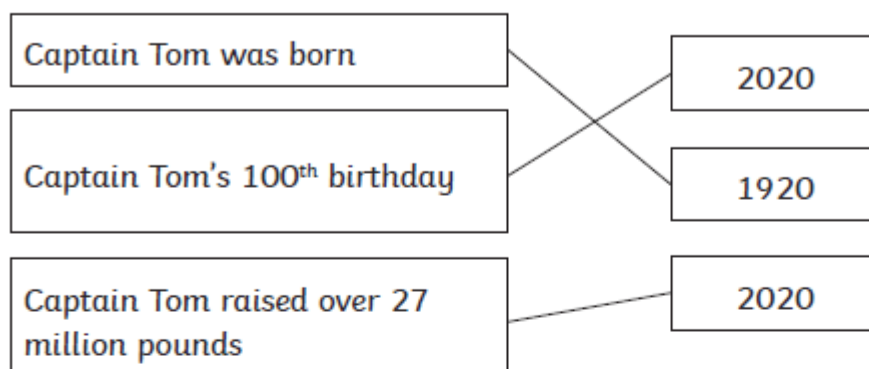
