Nursery Phonics Timetable

Read Write Inc <u>Fred Talk</u> Fred is a small toy frog used in Read Write Inc. Phonics to help children practise blending sounds together. Fred can only speak in sounds so he needs children to say the words for him.  Speaking like Fred will help children to understand that words are made up of sounds. Words that are sounded out in Fred Talk have been written as they should be said rather than how they are spelled e.g. h-or-s rather than horse.	Fred Games-Fred Food Tell your child that Fred is feeling hungry. Adult says "Fred wants to eat some..." You as Fred, say b-r-e-d. Your child copies the sounds b-r-e-d and says the word bread. Repeat with other food: s-oo-p soup j-a-m jam c-ay-k cake b-u-n bun ch-ee-z cheese Your child may need you to model and help them to hear the full words at first.	Fred Games-Nursery Rhymes Use nursery rhymes that your child already knows really well. At the end of each line, Fred talk the most common rhyme. Children to only say the word that they hear this time. They do not need to copy the Fred talk in this game. Humpty Dumpty sat on a w-or-ll Humpty Dumpty had a great f-or-ll All the king's horses and all the king's m-e-n Couldn't put Humpty together a-g-e-n.	Fred Games-Story Fred Make up and tell a variety of simple short stories. Say some of the last words of each sentence in Fred Talk. Ask your child to repeat the sounds and then the whole word. E.G. One day a little girl went to the bus stop to catch the b-u-s. When the bus arrived it took her to her local sh-o-p. At the shop she bought f-oo-d. She walked home and was so tired that she went to b-e-d.	Fred Games-Guess Who is Coming to T-ea? Read the beginning of the sentence, then use Fred talk. Your child needs to repeat the sounds and say the words. His name is S-a-m. We will have bread and j-a-m. We can have s-oo-p. We will have jelly and c-ay-k. I can hear the b-e-ll. Come in S-a-m. Welcome to my h-ou-s. I will make the tea while you sit d-ow-n. Help me set the table. You need a s-p-oo-n. I need a s-p-oo-n. Repeat story with different items for the table: n-igh-f and f-or-k, b-ow-l and p-l-ay-t.	Fred Games-What a Mess! Read the beginning of the sentence, then use Fred talk. Your child needs to repeat the sounds and say the words. I go into my little girl's bedroom. What a m-e-ss! So many toys on the b-e-d. Jigsaw pieces on the f-l-or. Piles of b-oo-k-s. Broken bits of t-r-u-ck. So many clothes: a d-r-e-ss, a sh-ir-t, s-o-ck-s Think of other places in the house that could be a mess e.g. in the bathroom. So many things: s-oa-p, t-ow-l, b-r-u-sh.
