Amen.***

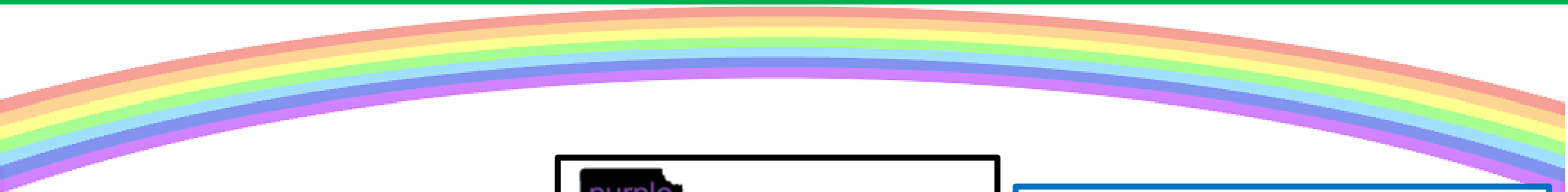
By doing this, although we can't be together Physically, we will be together as a school family in prayer.

Maths

Draw a picture of your house. What number house do you live at? Write the number on your picture. How many people live in your house? Draw that many people in your house.

Draw a picture of the biggest thing that you can think of that God created. Draw a picture of the smallest thing you can think of that God created.

Draw and cut out a variety of 2D shapes e.g. circles, squares etc. Put them together to make a shape picture of something that God made e.g. a person, fish, a flower, a tree, stars, sun and moon etc. Talk about the shapes that you have used.

Understanding the World

Make your own recycling boxes. Put your rubbish into a pile and sort it out into the different groups e.g. paper and card, plastic and glass.

Do some bird watching (remember you need to be quiet and still so you don't frighten the birds away). Observe the birds outside, which different birds can you see? Can you see a magpie like Morris the bird from the story 'The Messy Magpie'? What are the birds doing?

Take photographs of the different birds that you spot e.g. A Sparrow, a Blackbird, a Seagull, a Magpie, a Robin, a Pigeon etc.

Look at a picture of a map of the world. Explain that the green is the land and the blue is the seas. Can you find our country? Where do you live in this wide world? When you go outside look at your local environment, where is your house? What is your address? Where is your school?

Expressive Art and Design

Reuse junk to make a pair of binoculars for bird watching and to look for all of the things that God created.

Design and draw your own reusable shopping bag.

Draw or paint a picture on paper or on a paint programme of the beautiful things that God created e.g. you, your family, animals on land, animals in the sea, flowers, trees, the sun, moon and stars.
