Physical Development

Make a den indoors or outdoors for you and your teddy bears. You could read to them or tell them a story. What other stories do you know about bears?

Communication & Language

Speaking and listening underpins all of these activities. Make time to talk, have conversations and ask questions about daily life, activities, stories, games and movies etc.

Personal Social & Emotional

How would you feel if you were Baby Bear?

What do you think Goldilocks needs to do now? She has eaten the Bears porridge and broken Baby Bears chair.

How can we show that we are sorry?

Literacy

Share the story book 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. If you haven't got the book at home you can watch it here:

Draw a story map to help you remember and retell the story. Draw a picture of the Bears cottage, the three bowls of porridge, the three chairs and the three beds. Draw a picture of Goldilocks running away.

Make and write an invitation to your own teddy bears to invite them to a breakfast tea party.

Maths

Sort real life objects according to size e.g. biggest bowl, the smallest spoon etc.

Learn all about number one, number two and number three: Use objects from around the house and make sets of 3. Ask how many? Count to check. Take photographs of your sets of three e.g. 3 bowls, 3 chairs, 3 spoons etc. Write a tally mark for each set e.g. ||| Write the number 3.

Understanding the World

With help from an adult make breakfast and have a breakfast tea party with your teddy bears.

Find everyday objects around the house e.g. can of soup, TV remote, pillow etc. sort into two groups. Things that are HARD and things that are SOFT.

Expressive Art and Design
