Go on a walk and look out for vehicles, buildings, objects and signs linked to people who help us. Draw and label some of the things you saw on your walk which helped you think about people who help us. 	Write an 'I can' sentence about one person who helps us and draw a picture. Say sentence aloud and clap and stamp sentence together before your child writes it down. Lollipop lady - 'I can help you cross the road'. Mechanic - 'I can fix cars'.
