

RE: As followers of Christ we will learn ...

That Jesus prayed to the Father and they will be able to identify some of the prayers that he learnt growing up in the Jewish faith, some of the traditional prayers of the Church including the prayer of the Rosary.

As readers we will:

As scientists we will:

As physicists we will be learning how we hear sounds, how sounds are made and how they travel through the air.

As geographers we will:

Describe the maps of the world and learn about how rivers form and why they are important to different groups of people.

As mathematicians we will:

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 with a specific focus on the 11 and 12 times table. Multiply 3 numbers. Identify factor pairs. Use written methods to multiply 2 digits by 1 digit, 3 digits by 1 digit and divide 2 digits by 1 digit. Find and compare the area of shapes by counting squares and making shapes. Find and identify equivalent fractions. Understand and solve problems involving fractions greater than 1. Count in fractions. Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator. Calculate fractions of a quantity. Problem solving. Recognise tenths and hundredths and tenths as decimals. Recognise tenths and hundredths on a place value grid and a number line. Divide 1 and 2 digits by 10 or 100.

In PE will:

Develop our personal and fundamental movement skills by focussing on our coordination and balance. We will also be playing hockey.

As artists we will: Explore texture and pattern, developing a range of mark-making techniques, make and using our own textured stamps for printing. Moreover, we will be drawing a 'flip' pattern and recreating a famous and ancient geometric patterns

As designers we will: be budgeting for a designing our own biscuit, making it and evaluating our product.

In computing, we will: be learning about hardware and what different components a computer is made up of. Also, we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe online.
