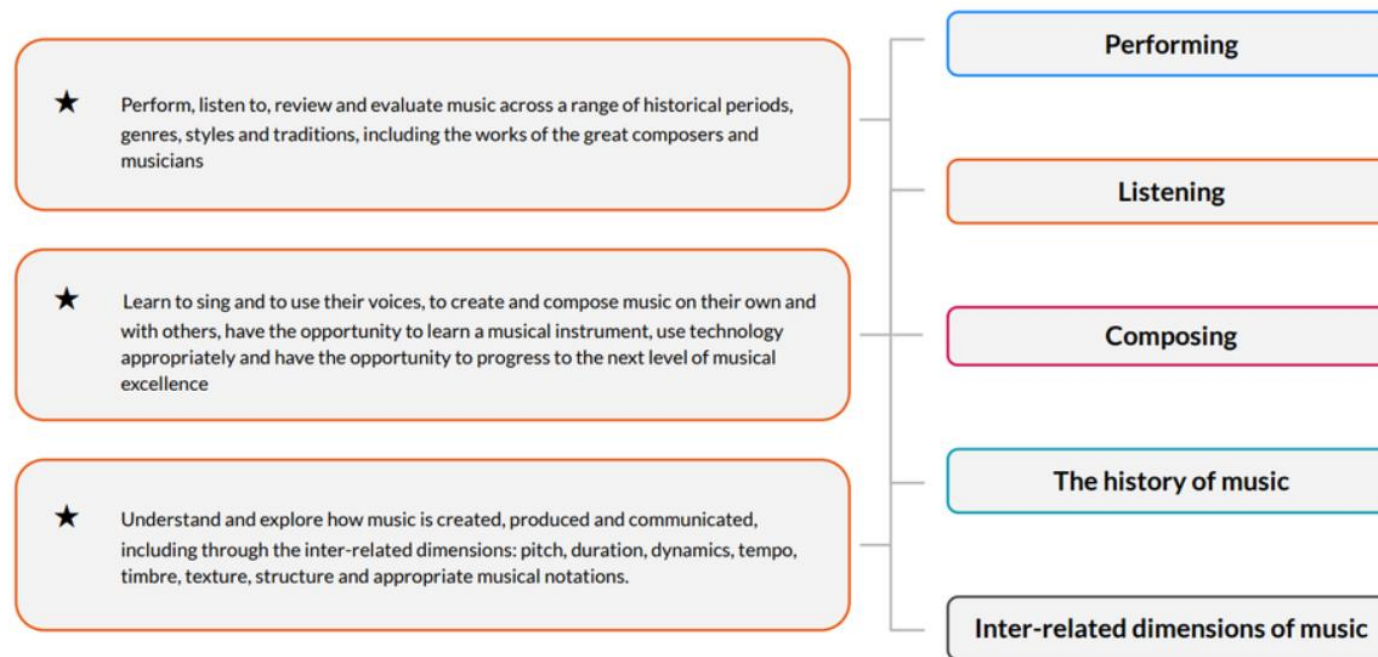


St Anne's Catholic Primary School
