



<p>Solidarity and the Common Good</p> <p>If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. 1 Corinthians 12:26</p> <p>And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.' Matthew 25:40</p>	<p>St. Therese of Lisieux</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · A patron of mission · Taught that through small, loving actions we can deliver God's love to the world. This teaching is called the 'Little Way' ·Each year, we participate in 'Little Way Week' which encourages people to do seven small actions – one a day for a week – to witness to their faith through service

Isaiah 1: 16</p> <p>Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy.
